





1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Haryana State Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
2. The school shall ensure that:-
  - (i) The school shall admit in class -1 to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.  
Provided that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
  - (ii) The school shall admit in class 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> under rule 134-A to the extent of 10% of the strength of the class for meritorious students belonging to economically weaker section.
3. That for the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub section (2) of section 12 to receive such reimbursements. School shall provide a separate bank account.
4. That for the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub section (2) of section 12 to receive such reimbursements. School shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. That the school shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof. If such admission is sought subsequent to the extent period specified for admission, the same shall not be denied and the child shall not be discriminated on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. That the school shall ensure that:-
  - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
  - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
  - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
  - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 22.
  - (v) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the Act.
  - (vi) The teachers are required with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualification shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years.
  - (vii) The teachers perform its duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act and
  - (viii) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.

8. That the school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by academic authority.
9. The school shall enrol students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 29 of the Act.
10. That the school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified section 19 of the Act.
