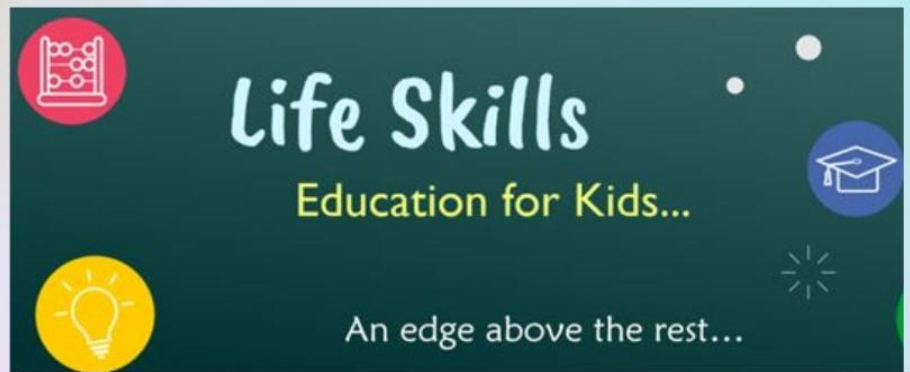
CELEBRATION OF CHANDRAYAAN -3 LAUNCH



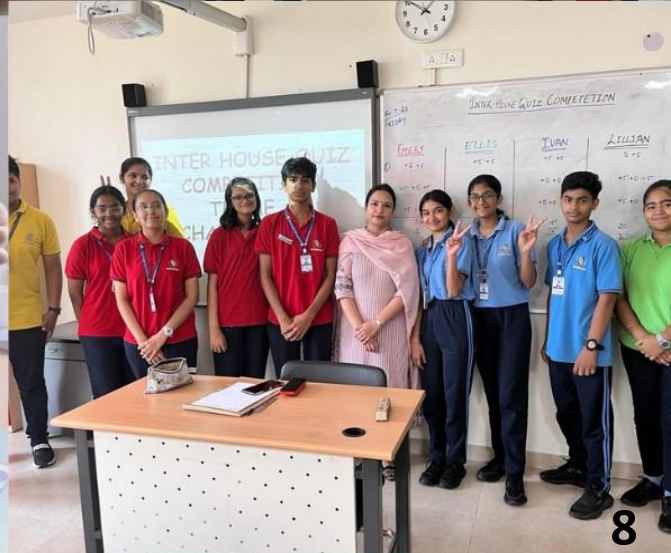
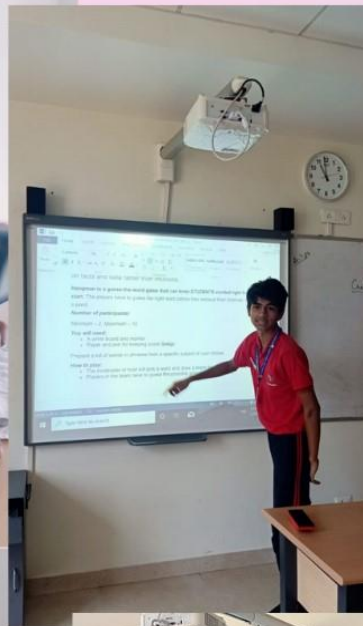

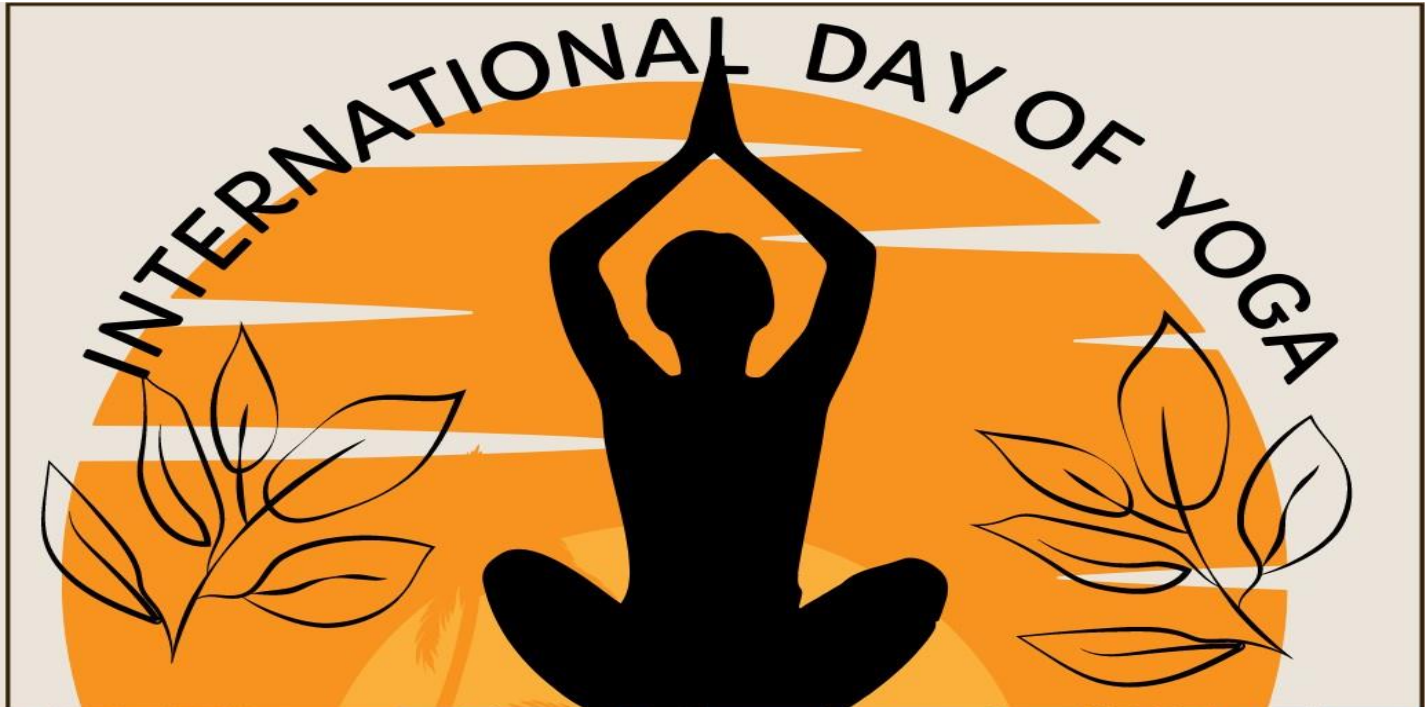

Weaving A Story

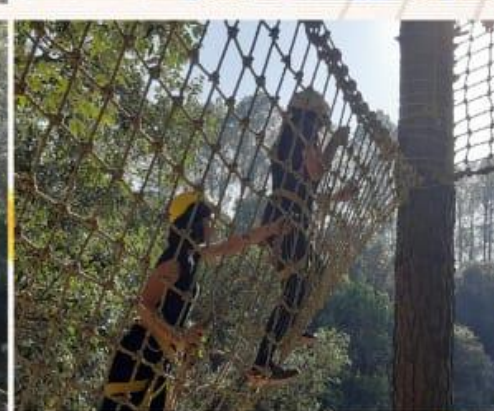
Speaking with confidence and fluency is one of the prime goals of language learning and what could be better when our learning becomes a source of entertainment and fun.

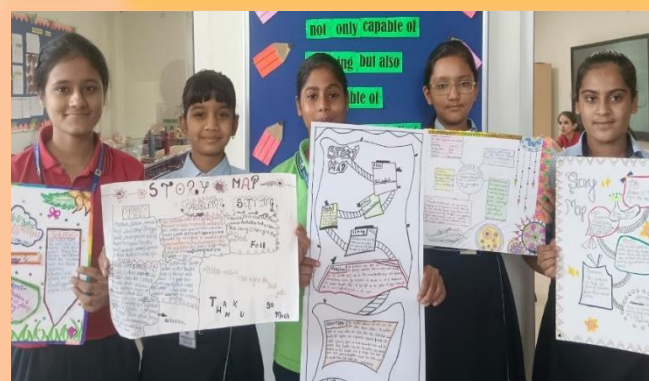
Poster Making on Recycling:

Life cycle of a butterfly



We all know the life cycle of human beings but do we know the amazing wheel of life of a butterfly. Humans once came out of mother's womb can't even think of spending a minute inside a dark room, but butterflies, on the other hand, create their own closet after hatching from their eggs.

CHANDRAYAAN-III (INDIA'S THIRD LUNAR MISHION)

Is India's Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft a boon or a bane? It is currently on a circuitous journey to the moon, performing a series of burns to raise its future orbit. Chandrayaan-3 was launched on July 14, entered an orbit around Earth, and has been gradually boosting its orbit in preparation for a final trajectory towards the moon.

The spacecraft's propulsion module completed its fourth orbit-raising maneuver on Thursday, July 20, as stated by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). This engine firing took place at the spacecraft's closest approach to Earth, increasing its apogee, which is the farthest point from Earth in its orbit.

The next firing is scheduled between 2 and 3 p.m. India Standard Time (0830-0930 GMT; 4:30-5:30 a.m. EDT) on July 25, according to ISRO. A translunar injection (TLI) burn is planned for July 31.

These maneuvers are part of Chandrayaan-3's low-energy approach to the moon, intended to facilitate a landing attempt on either August 23 or August 24.

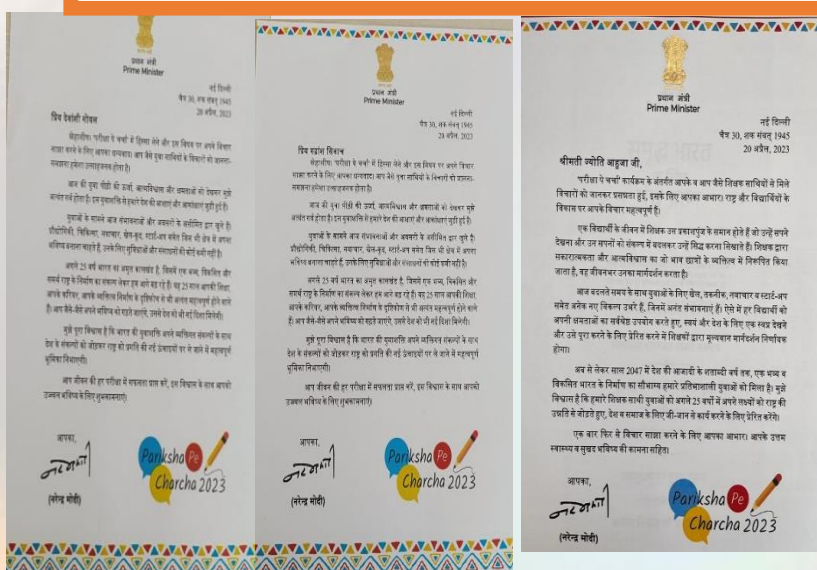

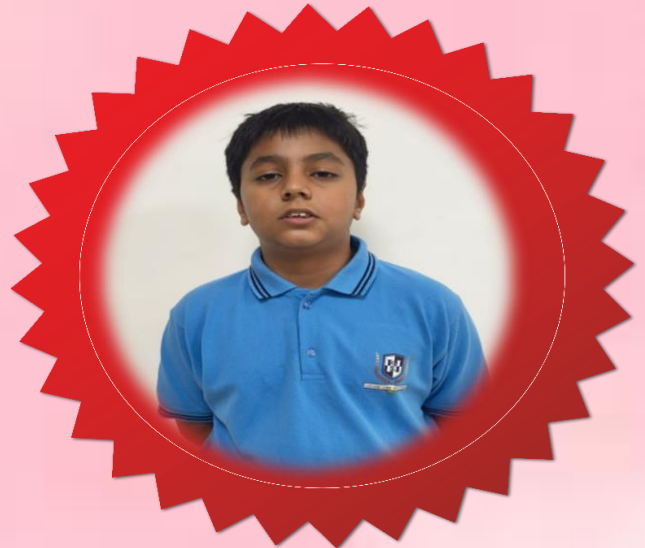
